

THE TRUE COST OF TEMPORARY SPACE

The true cost of temporary space is not just measured in the rent cost each month. It's measured in opportunity — specifically, opportunity lost.

While **BECA High School** has been a blessing to us — and we believe we have been a blessing to them, renting space severely limits our ministry.

We are limited in our capacity to expand ministry on Sunday morning.

We are limited in the ways we can utilize the space that is not our own.

We are limited in the programs we can host and we have to turn away key ministries.

We are limited in responding to the needs of our community.

While Locust Street has provided temporary space for offices, next generation, bible studies, and special worship services, as we predicted, it is not adequate.

GRACE WAS MADE TO SHINE!

Putting down physical roots is essential.

It is time for us to move from portable to permanent. There is no substitute for a true church campus if we are serious about mission, ministry, and impact.

THE TRUE BENEFIT OF PERMANENT SPACE

- BUILDINGS SHOW COMMITMENT
 When we put down roots, we will be making a statement that we're here for the long haul and are invested in the long-term good of our community.
- BUILDINGS FOSTER RELATIONSHIPS
 Relationships need a place to begin and to grow. A place where you live, laugh, and share together. A place that, over time, becomes home.
- BUILDINGS PROVIDE TRUE FLEXIBILITY
 Renting is often seen as flexible for the renter, but it's also limiting. We are limited by someone else's space and availability. At BECA we will never be able to host all of our current and future ministries. BECA is not available to us most of the week.
- BUILDINGS MAKE FINANCIAL SENSE
 Renting may make sense in the short-term
 and it has for us! However, we believe that
 we will be better stewards in the long-run by
 putting our financial resources into an asset we
 own and can use how and when we choose.
- BUILDINGS ARE A COMMUNITY ASSET
 With a building of our own, we can open our doors to community groups, performing arts, schools, clubs, and other groups who might otherwise never come in contact with GRACE—and Jesus.




SAMANTHA MCPEEK

... IS DIFFERENT FROM YOUR OTHER GRACE GIVING.

Giving to the SHINE Campaign is an "above and beyond" gift. This means that what you pledge to give is in addition to your regular giving to the church's operational budget.

... CAN BE MADE IN MANY WAYS.

There are ways you can participate other than giving cash. Some people have found it to be advantageous to give appreciated assets such as stocks. Additionally, people who are age 70 1/2 or older can benefit by giving from their IRA via a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). Your financial advisor can help you understand whether a gift like this could be a good option for you. Contact the church office if you have questions about any of these ways to give.

... IS A THREE-YEAR GIFT.

You can make your gift over three years: November 2019-October 2022. This allows you to give over 4 fiscal, or tax years.

IS SHINE PART OF THE ANNUAL CAMPAIGN THAT TYPICALLY HAPPENS IN THE FALL?

No. SHINE is a completely separate fund to pay for the campus at our new property.

A financial commitment to the SHINE Campaign is in addition to your ongoing giving to support the ministry of GRACE Church.

Normally, we would make our commitments for the annual operating budget in the fall. However, since we are doing the SHINE Campaign at that time, we will make our commitments for ongoing ministry funding in January/February 2020. In the meantime, it is important that we all continue to give strong to the ministry fund which fuels everything the church does on a day-to-day basis.

WHAT IF I HAVE NEVER GIVEN TO GRACE CHURCH BEFORE? IS THIS THE RIGHT WAY TO START?

If you have never given financially to GRACE, our SHINE Campaign is the perfect way to make that important first step! By doing so, you are investing not only in the mission and vision of GRACE Church, but you are investing in your Bethlehem neighborhood and neighbors.

We are not building a church for ourselves only. Yes — it will primarily be a place of mission and ministry. But we also want it to be a community resource, an inviting place where believers and non-believers alike can meet and grow in friendships. Ultimately, our goal is that at some point and in some way, every person who walks through our doors will learn about Jesus and feel His love coming from His people.

WHAT IF I AM STRUGGLING WITH DEBT RIGHT NOW? AM I STILL SUPPOSED TO GIVE?

If you are working to pay off debt right now, congratulations! The Bible very clearly teaches that being debt-free and the financial freedom it affords is very important to God.

However, the Bible does not teach that we withhold giving until we are debt-free. When we honor God first with our giving, He promises to be involved with every other aspect of our finances as well. (See Malachi 3:10-12)

WILL I BE ABLE TO CHANGE MY THREE-YEAR COMMITMENT IF I NEED TO?

Of course! No one can see clearly three years into the future. Situations change — both positively and negatively. You may want to increase or decrease your giving commitment at some point during the three-year pledge period. Therefore, you can change your pledge at any time by contacting the finance office.

WHEN DO WE EXPECT CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN? HOW WILL IT AFFECT OUR CURRENT MINISTRIES?

As you can imagine, we hope to move forward as quickly as possible. The financial results of the SHINE Campaign will be an important factor in how we can move forward. There are also many other factors that will impact a construction schedule. Given the information we have available now, we hope to begin construction in July 2020. Once construction begins, we expect that it will take approximately 18 months. This could possibly allow us to celebrate Christmas in our new home in 2021! We will continue to update the congregation as timelines become more clear.

WHAT ABOUT THE LOCUST STREET PROPERTY? IF WE ARE MOVING, CAN'T WE SELL THAT AND USE THE PROCEEDS FOR THE NEW PROPERTY?

Good question. There are a few different ways we could choose to use the Locust Street property going forward, and selling the property is one of them. However, we have not made a final decision. There is a mortgage on the property, so we would not realize the full value of the sale price. Once the SHINE Campaign results are in, the Session will evaluate all possible funding sources, including the sale of the Locust Street property, and will make a recommendation on how we should move forward.
