- Be willing to discuss matters of Christian faith in a trusting, secure, and non-judgmental way, both inside and outside of the team
- Have confidence to engage the congregation in worship
- Actively pursue spiritual maturity through prayer, study, and fellowship



## WORSHIP TEAM COVENANT

### **BEHAVIORAL - ROMANS 12:1-2**

- Serving on the worship team is an honor that puts you in a public light. We strive to live a life worthy of the calling we have received from Jesus Christ, and to be a witness to the good news of salvation by the way we live our lives.
- Communicate openly and honestly (avoid gossip and complaining; express needs)
- Accept constructive criticism and mentoring in both lifestyle and musical contexts.

### **HOW WE PREPARE - GALATIANS 6:9**

- Commit to practicing and preparing, prior to scheduled rehearsals and services
- Seek help from other team members, as needed, with individual parts
- Pray and seek God's guidance

### **HOW WE SHOW UP - COLOSSIANS 3:23-24**

- Prepare and set up your personal equipment (i.e., instruments, in-ears, smart phones/ tablets) before the designated start time
- Be willing to participate in set up and tear down as your schedule permits
- Be open to God's will and the presence of the Holy Spirit
- Wear attire that does not distract from the worship experience.

**If it appears a member is struggling with any of the expectations, team leadership will lovingly reach out, following the steps in Matthew 18:15-18, if applicable.**

## » **Scripture References**

**HEBREWS 10:24-25** - We must also consider how to encourage each other to show love and to do good things. We should not stop gathering together with other believers, as some of you are doing. Instead, we must continue to encourage each other even more as we see the day of the Lord coming.

**PSALM 33:3** - Sing to him a new song; play skillfully, and shout for joy.

**2 CORINTHIANS 3:16,18** - But whenever someone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.

## WORSHIP TEAM COVENANT

**ROMANS 12:1-2** - Offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, dedicated to his service and pleasing to him. This is the true worship that you should offer. 2 Do not conform yourselves to the standards of this world, but let God transform you inwardly by a complete change of your mind. Then you will be able to know the will of God—what is good and is pleasing to him and is perfect.

**GALATIANS 6:9** - Let us not grow weary in well-doing, for in due time we will reap a harvest, if we do not give up.

**COLOSSIANS 3:23-24** - Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

**MATTHEW 18: 15-18** - If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church; and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector.
